Accessing Refugee Arrival Data System (RADS) 3.2

- An email requesting access must be sent by the grantee to rads@acf.hhs.gov in order to request new user access.
- A registration email will be sent to the email provided.
- A new user has up to 24 hours to login before temporary password expires.
- New users will be asked to create password and set up security questions prior to entering RADS 3.2.
- There is an account authentication process which sends a one time use PIN to your email account once you attempt to login. You will need to enter the PIN on the screen provided to continue with the login process.



Instructions

- Login to: <https://rads.acf.hhs.gov/rads/>
- Go to SOT → Queue.
- Click New to start a new SOT form.
- Expand the form, fill in the details.
- Click the Save button.
 - Saving the form allows you to continue to edit the information before submitting the form.
- Click the Submit button.
 - You can no longer edit the information on the form.
 - Note: Do not submit the form until you have completed entering all your information.
- Grantee can edit the form prior to the submission and then only in case of rejection by ORR.
