Data Points 5 &13: Country Where Torture Occurred and Country of Origin

- All countries included
- "Other" option shouldn't be used
- Alphabetic, but check for countries known by more than one name
 The Democratic People's Republic of Korea listed as North Korea
 Burma listed as Myanmar
- Double-check countries with similar names
 Congo, The Republic of vs. Congo, The Democratic Republic of
 Equatorial Guinea vs Guinea vs Guinea Bissau (vs. Papua New Guinea)
- Certain autonomous regions, contested territories, and states not universally recognized as sovereign are also included (e.g., Taiwan, Tibet, Palestine, etc.)

Data Point 14: Ethnicity


- Ethnicity is not the same as Nationality or Country of Origin (but, sometimes it is); definitions of some ethnicities may overlap
 - Somali vs Bantu: Somali
 - Lhotshampa (Bhutanese) vs Nepali
 - Hispanic/Latino vs Mayan
- Bantu, Mandé, Maya groups

 Maya: Kekchi, Q'eqchi are different than K'iche', Quiché. For K'iche, Quiché, enter as Maya: Other
